1st Floor



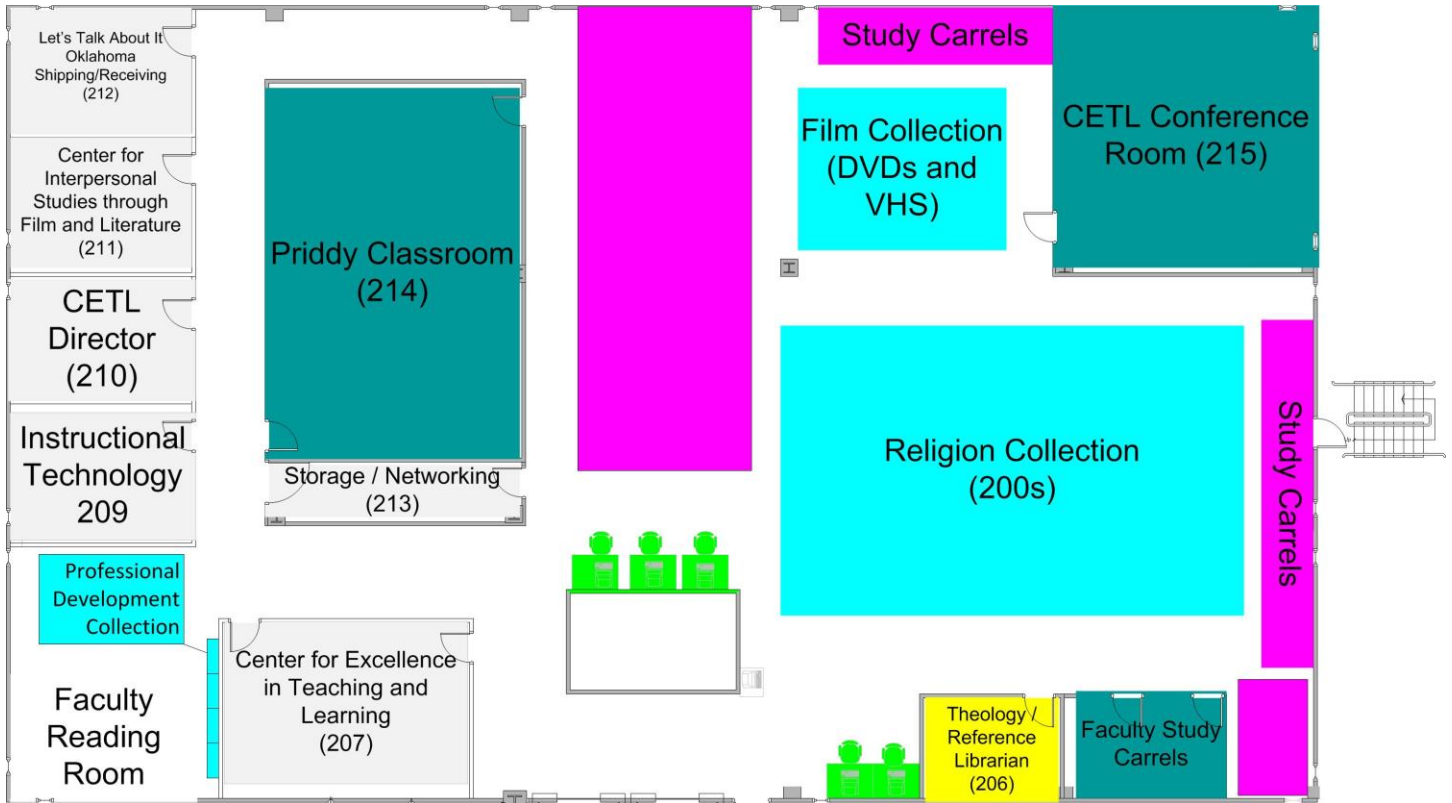

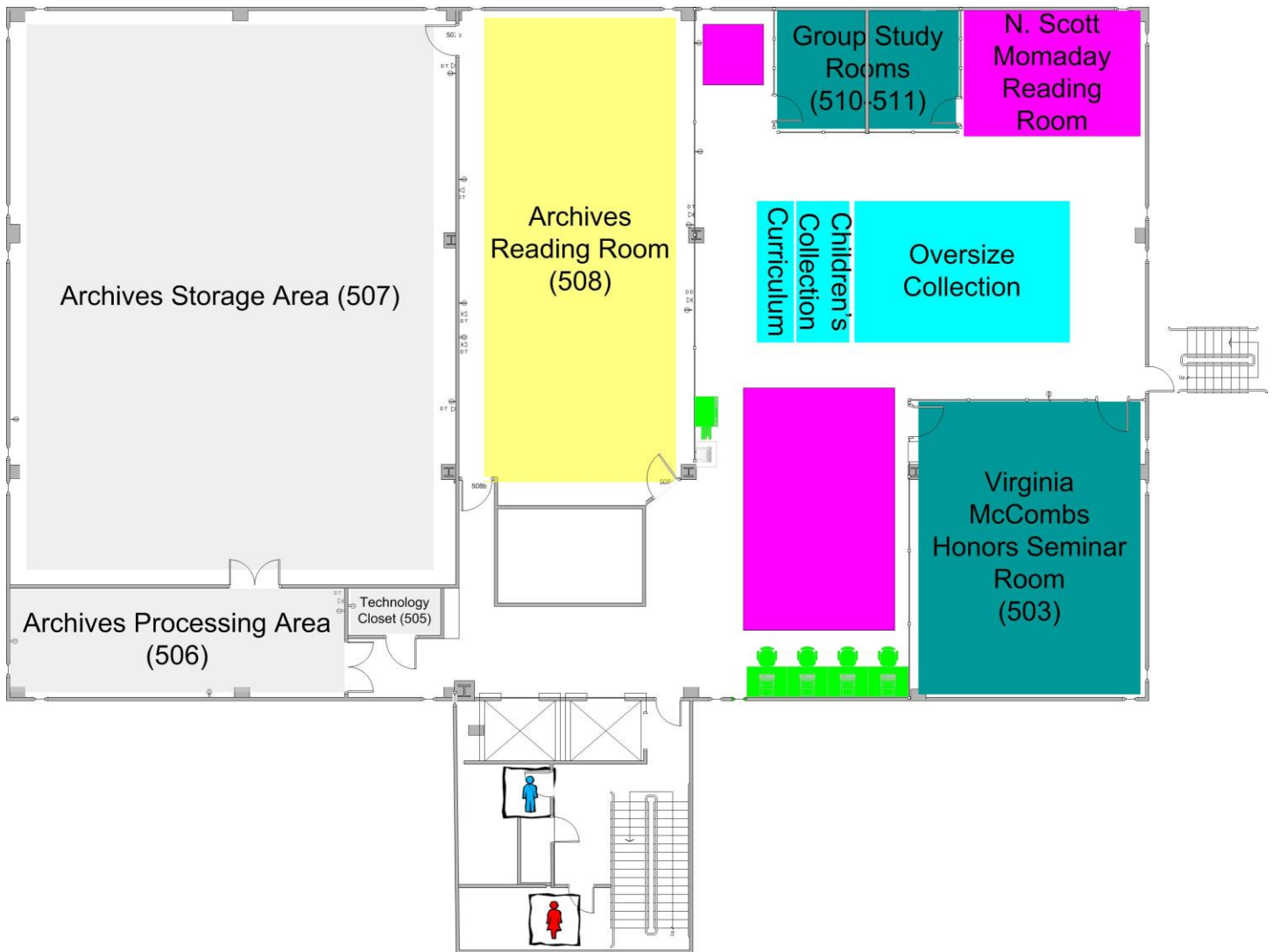
